

AAHRPP 2018 Annual Conference: Call for Session Proposals

AAHRPP is currently accepting session proposals for our main 2018 Annual Conference in Denver, Colorado on April 21-22, 2018.

Opens: September 25, 2017

Closes: November 3, 2017

Based on the enthusiastic response and successful sessions that emerged from our inaugural call for session proposals last year, AAHRPP is delighted to once again solicit proposals from interested individuals to fill a limited number of allocated break-out sessions at the 2018 AAHRPP Annual Conference. Proposals that will be given the strongest consideration should include a presentation of innovative practices, “how to” ideas for meeting AAHRPP standards, and/or cutting edge ideas, consistent with our conference theme, “Summitting New Heights in the Mile High City: Early Experiences, Strategies, and Solutions.”

Proposals will be accepted from all sectors of the human research enterprise, including representatives of AAHRPP-accredited organizations, “not yet accredited but interested” organizations, and consultants knowledgeable in human research protections. PLEASE NOTE, however, that individuals from the latter two categories (that is, not-yet-accredited organizations and consultants) are required to team up with someone from an accredited organization and submit a joint proposal.

Proposals Should Include:

- An abstract of 300 words or less

- Format of the presentation

- Proposed speakers
